The core-curriculum, which focuses its foundation on learning in both English and French, is taught by dual-language faculty members.

In addition to the core-curriculum that FASP offers, students will have the opportunity to participate in activities and clubs. Starting this school year, the French Soccer Academy will coach the school's soccer team.

As the academic year kicks off, the 2019-2020 school year also marks the 20th anniversary of FASP; a school which was founded in 2000 with only five students in a church, located within the heart of Princeton.

Head of School Corinne Güngör anticipates the school year with increased excitement of the milestone anniversary.

"This will be an exciting year for us," said Güngör. "We are eager to have young minds who are ready to learn and succeed in a vibrant and welcoming bilingual environment."
